Grand Lux Cafe, an upscale casual restaurant concept, was inspired through Mr. Overton's travels through Europe delighting in the grand bistros, pastry shops and grand cafes of Italy and Vienna. In typical Cheesecake Factory fashion, Grand Lux Cafe will deliver sensory pleasure through global cuisine, architecture, décor design all in a casual atmosphere.
