SanTan Village's four other newest additions - Maui Wowi, Dairy Queen, Auntie Anne's and Yogurberry - aim to serve the desire for quick, family friendly eats.

SanTan Village is a market-driven super regional shopping center with about 130 retailers and restaurants. It sits at the heart of a thoughtfully designed

mixed-use urban village in the core of the Southeast Valley's emerging retail corridor. At build out, SanTan Village will encompass 3 million square feet on 500 acres including retail, entertainment, restaurant and office space.
